

Kettlewell with Starbotton Parish Council

Meeting held Wednesday 11 May 2016, 7.30pm in Kettlewell Village Hall

Present: Cllr Harvey (chair and minutes) Cllr Appleton, Cllr Lister, Cllr Parker and 11 members of the public.

Apologies: The Clerk (work commitments), County Councillor Marshall (at another meeting) and District Councillor Graham (previous commitment).

1. The Council thanked the outgoing Chair and councillors for all their hard work and commitment to the community in the past.

2. **Declaration of interest**

Cllr Appleton declared an interest regarding the Cam Garth housing.

3. **Minutes of the previous meeting**

It was resolved that the minutes of the meeting held on 6 April 2016 were a correct record and they were signed.

4. **Matters arising from previous minutes:**

- a. It was resolved that a meeting should be arranged with Andy Mellor (Highways) in June and that Cllr Appleton and Mr Wilkinson should be present. **Action Clerk**
- b. Kettlewell defibrillator defective part. Mr Nelson was not present so this matter was unresolved and should be on the next agenda **Action Clerk**
- c. Mr Belk informed the council that he had undertaken a War Memorial safety report and that he would give this to Cllr Appleton. **Action Mr Belk**
- d. Mr Belk informed the council that he has identified the damage to the fencing of the football field and will make the necessary repairs. **Action Mr Belk**
- e. Cllr Parker informed the council that the cost of changing the street light bulbs range from £10 to £30 depending on the wattage. Mr Wilkinson informed the council that there is still a stock of old bulbs to be used. The council agreed to use these first and to revisit this matter in the future.
- f. Mr Wilkinson informed the council that he has the replacement neighbourhood watch sign for the Roebuck homes.
- g. Mr Belk reported to the council that he had attended a meeting of the YDNP parish forum and that in his opinion this forum is very helpful and will be worth attending in the future.
