

Kettlewell with Starbotton Parish Council

Meeting held on 1 May 2019 at 8pm in Kettlewell Village Hall

Present: Cllr Macefield (chair), Cllr Parker, Spillett (clerk), County Cllr Quinn (from item 8) and 7 members of the public.

1. **Apologies**

Cllr Appleton (at work) and Cllr Lister (at work).

2. **Declarations of interest**

No declarations of interest were made.

3. **Minutes of the previous meeting**

It was resolved that the minutes of the meeting held on 3 April 2019 were a correct record and they were signed.

4. **Reports from North Yorkshire County Council and Craven District Council.**

- a. There was no report from CDC. Cllr Graham would be thanked for her work in past years. **Action Cllr Spillett**
- b. The report from NYCC was given later, when Cllr Quinn joined the meeting.

5. **Planning**

It was noted that the YDNP had refused application C/46/157J, for full planning permission for erection of open fronted storage shed on land adjacent Crookadyke Farm, Kettlewell.

6. **Accounts**

It was noted that on 22 March 2019, Barclays Business Saver had £8,371 and the Community Account £100.

7. **Correspondence**

In response to a letter requesting a timeframe to resolve the concern over the posts on the Kettlewell Village Green, it was noted the council would be going to its solicitor promptly.

8. **Matters arising from the minutes**

It was noted that:

- a. The organiser of the proposed Pilates classes intends to start them in the autumn.
- b. The resubmission of Highways issues through the portal had not yet been made. **Action Cllr Spillett**
- c. The litter-pick would be at 10am on Sunday 12 May. **Action Cllrs Macefield and Spillett**
- d. There was no street lighting update, but it was agreed to investigate replacing the light at the vicarage. **Action Cllr Parker**
- e. A surround sound microphone had been donated by Mr R Lambert and he would be thanked. **Action Cllr Spillett**

- f. Kettlewell stocks are to be replaced with a donation of wood and fitting by Mr C Lambert.
- g. Volunteers were still needed for the Emergency Committee. **Action Cllr Spillett**

9. **Report from NYCC**

Cllr Quinn gave a report. She confirmed part of any future members' budget could be spent on small scale Highways work. **Action Cllr Macefield**

10. **Matters raised by the public**

It was reported/ requested that:

- a. That there had been discussion of the Market Place in a Council meeting of late 2004 or early 2005. The meeting minutes would be searched. **Action Cllr Spillett**
- b. The dog waste bin near the playing fields has disappeared and should be replaced. **Action Cllr Spillett**
- c. Anne Vetch be invited to a future meeting in order to outline Kettlewell School changes. **Action Cllr Spillett**
- d. Local facilities should be used, to support sustainability of the parish.
- e. The light at Manningham House has been out for years and the Council was still paying for electricity to be supplied to it.
- f. The War Memorial land (given to the Council by the Skipton District Council) is not registered.
- g. Traffic wardens should be asked to visit Kettlewell and notice be put in the Link requesting people to parking sensibly so that emergency service vehicles have room to pass. **Action Cllr Spillett**
